

Bard Health Service can assist students with information about travel immunizations however, we do not keep many vaccinations in stock (currently only PPD and Tdap are easily available). We can write prescriptions for oral malaria and typhoid prevention medications which will have to be filled at a local pharmacy. Please be aware that some immunizations require multiple visits for completion, therefore planning ahead is essential. Another consideration is that it takes about four weeks after vaccination to develop immunity. We encourage you to research the Center for Disease Control website (<http://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel>) for your particular destination before making your appointment for your immunizations.
