If you are a survivor of sexual harassment, sexual assault, relationship abuse, or being stalked, you have the right:

- To be treated with respect and informed of all your options
- Press/file charges
 - Both with Police and/or On Campus
- Free Medical Care
- Free Advocacy and Support
- Request a restraining or no contact order
- Request accommodations to make you feel safe and help minimize the burden on your educational program
