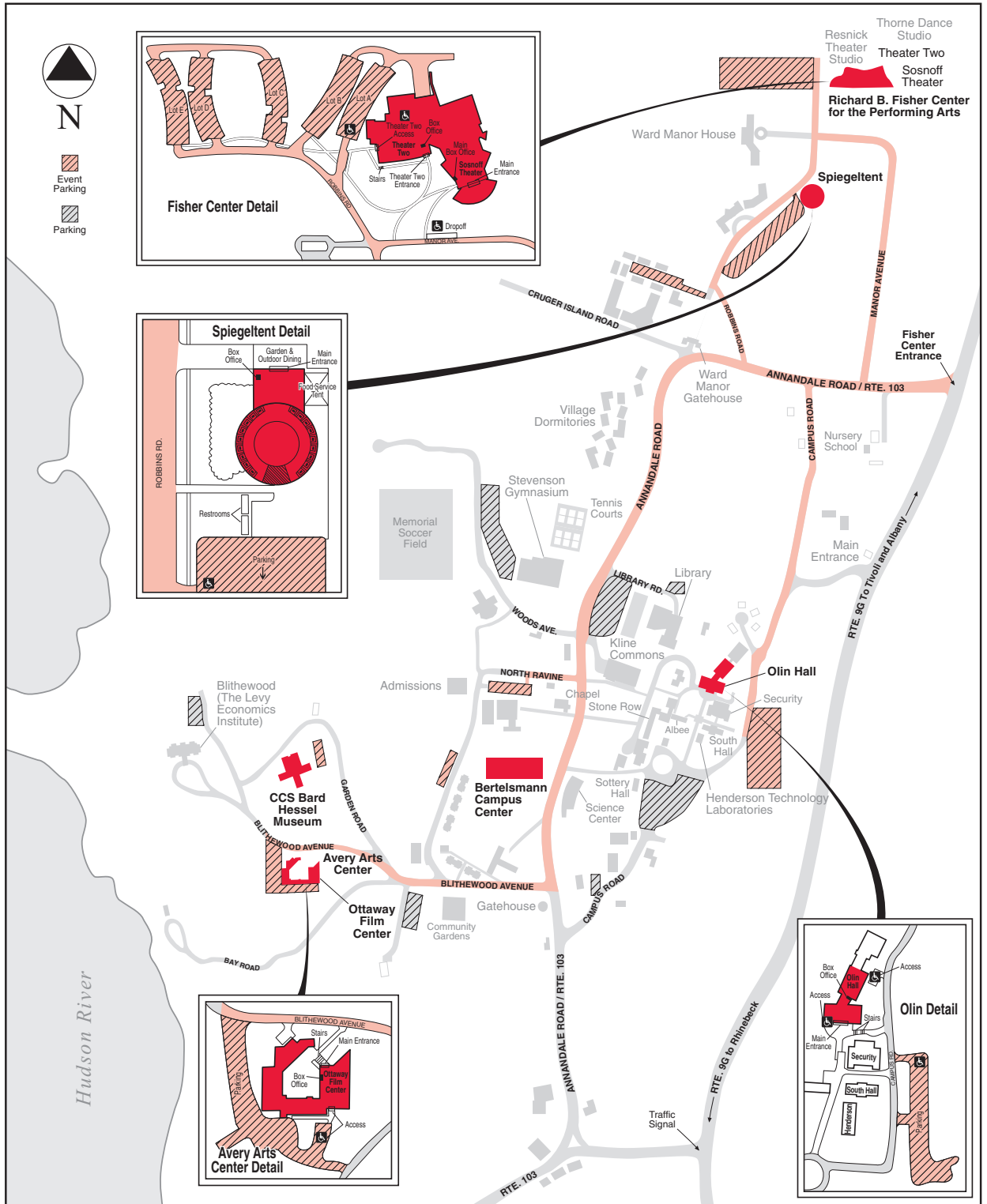

Box Office

The main Box Office, located in the lobby of the Sosnoff Theater, is open Monday through Friday from 10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Other Box Office locations are open one hour prior to the performance. Please pick up tickets in the venue of the performance that you will be attending.

Parking

Handicapped parking spaces are available at all venues. Reserved Parking is available for drivers with disabilities at the Sosnoff Theater, Theater Two, and the Spiegelent. Drivers of cars accompanying the disabled are asked to drop their passengers off at the drop-off point in front of the Fisher Center for performances at these venues. Please call 845-758-7948 in advance to ensure that a space is reserved for you. Unreserved handicapped parking spaces are available at Avery Arts Center, and Olin Hall.

The Fisher Center utilizes golf carts to assist patrons with disabilities between the parking lot and theater. Golf carts cannot run during lightning or icy conditions. In the event that the carts are not running please request assistance from a parking attendant and a staff member will escort you to the theater. Golf cart transportation is not available at Avery Arts Center or Olin Hall.

Travel to Bard

BY AUTOMOBILE

From New York City, New Jersey, and points south,

take the New York State Thruway to Exit 19 (Kingston), take Rte. 209 (changes to Rte. 199 at the Hudson River) over the Rhinecliff Bridge to the second light, turn left onto Rte. 9G, and drive north 3.8 miles. Turn left onto Annandale Rd./Rte. 103 and follow sign for Center for Performing Arts.

From Albany, take the New York State Thruway to Exit 19 and proceed as from New York City.

From southern Connecticut, follow I-84 to the Taconic State Parkway, take the Taconic north to the Red Hook/Rte. 199 exit, drive west on Rte. 199 through the village of Red Hook to Rte. 9G, turn right onto Rte. 9G, and drive north 1.9 miles. Follow sign for Center for Performing Arts.

From northern Connecticut, take Route 44 to Route 199 at Millerton, drive west on Rte. 199, and proceed as from southern Connecticut.

From Massachusetts and northern New England, take the Massachusetts Turnpike to Exit B-2 (Taconic Parkway), take the Taconic south to the Red Hook/Rte. 199 exit, and proceed as from southern Connecticut.

BY TRAIN

Amtrak provides service from Penn Station, New York City, and from Albany to Rhinecliff, about 9 miles south of Annandale: www.amtrak.com

BY COACH

For information or to make a reservation on the round-trip coach being provided for specific performances (noted with an asterisk in the brochure), call the Box Office at 845-758-7900. The fare is \$10 round-trip. Reservations are required. The coach will leave from Columbus Circle four hours prior to the scheduled curtain time to allow for dining in the Spiegelent or a visit to the CCS Bard Hessel Museum prior to the performance. *Offered only to ticket holders.*

PARKING

TOURS

Tours of the Sosnoff Theater in the Fisher Center for the Performing Arts take place Monday through Friday at 2:00 pm. The tour is \$5 per person and begins in the lobby of the Sosnoff Theater. No reservations are required. The tour runs approximately thirty to forty five minutes. Tours will include those parts of the building that are available for viewing at the time of the tour.
