In person: The box office is located in The Richard B. Fisher Center for the Performing Arts at Bard College, in the Sosnoff Theater lobby. Hours are Monday to Friday, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The box office also opens two hours before each scheduled performance. Advance ticket sales stop one hour prior to curtain.

DISCOUNTS

Discounted tickets will be marked by the box office and checked at the door. Discounts apply only to the individual for whom the ticket is purchased. Only one discount per ticket purchased is permitted.

Senior citizens, age 62 and over, are eligible for a discount of \$4 per single ticket purchased.

Students, ages 5 to 18, and college and graduate students with a valid school ID are eligible for a discount of \$15 per single ticket purchased.

Groups of 15 or more may be eligible for a discount. Please call the box office manager at 845-758-7948.

OTHER INFORMATION

Latecomers are not admitted to the theater after the performance has begun. Closed-circuit TVs are available in the lobby of Theater Two for patrons to view the performance. Ushers will direct patrons to their seats during a suitable pause, but this may not be until an intermission. Patrons who need to leave the theater during a performance will be readmitted only during a suitable pause.

Children under age 5 may attend age-appropriate events only. Check with the box office. Infants will not be admitted to performances.

The use of recording equipment or photography is strictly prohibited during performances.

Mobile phones, beepers, and watch alarms must be turned off during performances.

Lost and found is located in the box office in the Sosnoff Theater.

If you have forgotten or misplaced your tickets, the box office can reprint them for you. Stop by the box office prior to the performance.

ACCESS AND FACILITIES FOR THE DISABLED

Wheelchair seating in Theater Two varies for each production. *Please be sure to let the box office know at the time you purchase your tickets that you will need wheelchair seating so that an appropriate location can be reserved for you.*

Restrooms throughout the Fisher Center are wheelchair accessible.

Sennheiser infrared assistive listening devices are available in Theater Two. Receivers may be borrowed on request at the box office.

Reserved parking is available for drivers with disabilities. Please call 845-758-7948 in advance to ensure a reserved space. Drivers of cars carrying the disabled are asked to drop their passengers off at the drop-off point in front of the Fisher Center.
