Yuzhe Cai is a professional harpist and dedicated teacher known for her expressive musicality and refined technique. A graduate of the Central Conservatory of Music in Beijing, she earned both her Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Harp Performance with honors.

Yuzhe has performed with many of China's leading orchestras, appearing in more than one hundred orchestral concerts across the country. Her repertoire includes major works by composers such as Gustav Mahler, Igor Stravinsky, Claude Debussy, and Maurice Ravel. She has also appeared as a guest artist at the University of Chicago.

She is currently a student in the Advanced Performance Studies program at the Bard College Conservatory of Music, studying with Mariko Anraku, Associate Principal Harp of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra.
