Xinri Zhang is a pianist currently pursuing a Master of Music degree in Piano Performance at the Bard College Conservatory of Music. She previously studied at the Zhejiang Conservatory of Music, following her early training at the Primary and Middle Schools affiliated with the Central Conservatory of Music in Beijing.

Xinri has received numerous awards in both national and international competitions, including First Prize at the Barletta International Young Musicians Competition in Italy, as well as top prizes at the Chopin Youth Piano Competition, the Coreno International Piano Competition, and the China Music Golden Bell Award (Zhejiang Selection). She has appeared in chamber music performances at major venues such as the Hangzhou Grand Theatre and the Zhejiang Conservatory of Music Concert Hall. Her principal teachers include Professors Rieko Aizawa, Jin Zhang, Mai Su, and Bo Tong.
