Pre-Health/Medicine/Science email listserv - Join the listserve to receive notifications of Science, Medicine, and Health-related internships, research, and employment opportunities within these fields. *Email Professor Frank Scalzo to be added to the listserv* - scalzo@bard.edu

Pre-Health & Medicine Overview Presentation - Attend a comprehensive presentation held once a semester for students with an interest in pursuing medicine and health. Advice includes recommended coursework as well as information about shadowing, internships, and gaining clinical hours - The presentation is promoted and usually held on Advising Days once a semester.

<u>BEMS (Bard EMS Squad)</u> - BEMS hires students to staff the Bard Emergency Medical Squad on-campus. Attend a BEMS Info Session to learn more. <u>Note</u>: Students must apply to be considered. Commitment to participate in intensive safety training and on-call hours is required.

Science Research Employers Recruiting - CDO participates in recruiting consortia programs offering first-round interviews for post-graduate career paths for graduating seniors interested in research assistant or technician positions - examples - Weill Cornell Medical, The Rockefeller, Memorial Sloan Kettering, Albert Einstein, and Mount Sinai.

Gain clinical hours and experience by working, volunteering, or shadowing at local hospitals, doctor's offices, public health programs, clinics, nursing and children's homes, and other care-related facilities or patient-focused organizations. Medical Schools typically look for clinical and/or service-related hours.

Many students interested in the field of medicine will apply for volunteer opportunities at hospitals local to their homes in the summer and winter months. <u>Note</u>: Students should apply early for consideration as this is a popular way for students from colleges and universities to gain some experience.

Students should research other ways to gain experience and get involved near campus or close to their homes. Volunteer or Internship opportunities can be listed on organization websites, online job search platforms, or simply by calling the medical or county office to inquire. <u>Note:</u> Depending on the experience, students may need to have specific vaccinations and complete confidentiality agreements to work/intern, or volunteer.
